## School Profile 2018-2019

**ENROLLMENT:** Total 259 students in grades 9-12, including 55 seniors; 68 juniors; 65 sophomores; and 71 freshmen.

**ACCREDITATION:** GSA is a public charter school accredited by the Missouri State Board of Education and holds membership in the College Board and the National Association for College Admission Counseling.

**SCHOOL ORGANIZATION:** Eight 45-minute periods daily, two semesters, 18 weeks each.

**COMMUNITY:** St. Louis is a major city in Missouri along the Mississippi River. GSA opened its doors to freshmen in August 2012 and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 2016.

**GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:** Students must complete a min. of 28 credits that include the following requirements.

## CURRICULUM:

**Grading:** GSA calculates grade point average on a **weighted 4.0** scale. (+,- included on a weight scale.)

The following breakdown is used:

A+= 4.00, A= 4.00, A-= 3.67, B+=3.33, B=3.00, B-=2.67, C+=2.33, C=2.00, C-=1.67, D+=1.33, D+=1.00, D-=1.00, F=0.

Honors, AP and Dual Enrollment courses are weighted by one point. Students must pass a course with a D (60). Failing grades are entered on transcript and included in GPA calculations.

**Rank:** GSA does not rank students.

**Honor Courses:** (12) Honors Algebra I, Honors Algebra II, Honors Geometry, Honors English II, Honors Biology, Honors Chemistry, Honors Physics, Honors World History, Honors U.S. History, Honors Government, Honors Spanish III, Honors Spanish IV.

**Advanced Placement Classes:** (8) AP courses are offered in AP U.S. History, AP English Language, AP Literature, AP Studio Art, AP Seminar, AP Statistics, AP Biology, and AP Calculus AB.

**Dual Credit Courses:** (8) Credit awarded by Saint Louis University, the University of Missouri-St. Louis, Lindenwood University, or St. Louis Community College in the following courses: The AP English Language, AP English Literature, AP US History, College Algebra, Intermediate Algebra, Economics, Personal Finance, The Processes of College Composition
